Award Rules

- Cash awards are based on gun time, not chip time.
- Runners can only win awards and/or cash prizes for the event they are officially registered in.
- Overall and Masters winners are not eligible for age group awards.
- Double (or triple) dipping is only allowed if a bonus award is achieved in conjunction with an overall award.
 - The Masters prize money of \$750 shall be paid to the highest placing masters athlete (age 40+ on race day) who finishes outside of the top six overall prize category.
- Pennsylvania resident and Steel City Road Runners member are the only bonus categories and are eligible for overall prize money and age group awards.
- Steel City Road Runners members must be registered for a basic membership or the Run for a Reason Charity Program membership by April 1, 2019 to be eligible for the Steel City Road Runners member prize money.

Drug Policy

The DICK'S Sporting Goods Pittsburgh Marathon has a zero tolerance drug policy. Athletes who participate in DICK'S Sporting Goods Pittsburgh Marathon events may be subject to drug testing conducted by the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) or other licensed entity. Athletes with positive drug test results will forfeit any prize money and will be disqualified from the event in which such athlete participated.
